Parent Consultations will take place in the week of 20th March. A letter will be sent out nearer the time regarding making your appointments at the School Office.

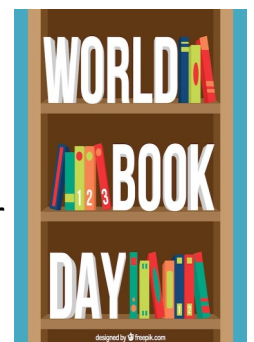


Year 6 SAT's workshop for Parents.
